TRUST DEED

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THIS TRUST DEED is made at New Delhi on this 19th day of December, 2006 by Shri. Arvind Kejriwal, S/o Shri G. R. Kejriwal, R/o 403 L Girnar, Kaushambi, Ghaziabad-201010, hereinafter referred to as the "SETTLOR" (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context, mean and include his heirs, successor, executors, administrators and legal representative).

AND

1. Shri Arvind Kejriwal, S/o Shri G. R. Kejriwal, R/o 403 L, Girnar, Kaushambi, Ghaziabad-201010.
2. Shri Abhinandan Sekhri, S/o Shri Ravindra Kumar Sekhri, R/o G 601, Som Vihar Appartments, R. K. Puram. New Delhi 110022
3. Shri Manish Sisodia, S/o Capt. D. P. Singh, R/o 350/4C, Vartalok, Vasundhra, Ghaziabad.

Hereinafter referred to as the "TRUSTEES" (which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, be deemed to include their heirs, successor or successors in office)

WHEREAS the SETTLOR, Magsaysay Award winner, is desirous of establishing a trust with the Magsaysay award money by initially contributing the award money so received, for the benefit of the society at large and to work for the objectives as described in paras hereinafter in this trust deed.

AND WHEREAS the SETTLOR for the charitable objects mentioned hereinafter has made over a sum of Rs. 1000/-/- (Rupees one thousand) vide Cheque No. 361110 dated 20th December 2006, in favour of the said trust by the way of initial contribution as CORPUS of the Trust.

AND WHEREAS the Trustees have agreed to become the trustees and to hold and apply the said sum of Rs. 1000/-/- (Rupees One thousand) and all gifts, contributions, subscriptions and donations received by the said Trust for the public charitable purposes.

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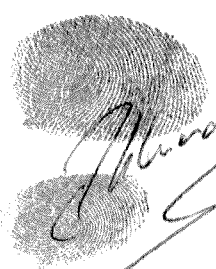


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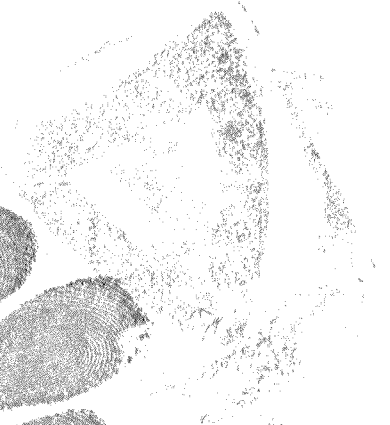


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NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AND IT IS HERE BY AGREED AND DECLARED AS FOLLOWS:

1. **NAME AND REGISTERED OFFICE OF THE TRUST**

- i. The Name of this Trust shall be "Public Cause Research Foundation"
- ii. The Registered Office of the trust shall be at 5/7 Basement, Sarupriya Vihar, New Delhi 110022 or such other place or places as the Board may decide from time to time.

2. **OBJECTS OF THE TRUST**

- i. To collect, study, analyze, research, disseminate and publish information about various aspects of governance, including policies, decisions, decision making processes and implementation of various government plans, programs and schemes and to take steps so that rules and laws are enacted and enforced.
- ii. To undertake such activities and programs that promote and lead to a just, transparent, accountable and participatory governance in India, lead to reduction in corruption and to promote equitable opportunities for development.
- iii. To educate people and organize various kinds of awareness programmes and activities regarding various laws and rights of the public.
- iv. To approach appropriate authorities including courts, whenever required, to achieve the objectives of the trust.
- v. To finance and contribute to other organisations engaged in similar objectives.
- vi. To publish periodicals, pamphlets, books and other literature and use other media for promoting the objects of the trust.
- vii. To associate with other organizations with similar objects in and outside India, for the furtherance of the objects of the trust.
- viii. To take over, run, manage and administer any existing organization with similar objectives.
- ix. To organize and take part in various camps as may be decided by the Board.
- x. To constitute scholarships, pay stipends, cash remuneration and incentives, presentations or awards and prizes in cash or in kind to promote the objects of this trust.
- xi. To organize seminar on social justice, educational and economical upliftment to raise legal demands and fundamentals rights provided by the Constitution of India.
- xii. To conduct various field studies and surveys for data collection.

- xiii. To take up effective, reasonable and lawful steps for the solution of such problems of the public as decided by the Board and which would promote the wider objects of the trust.
- xiv. To receive financial and non-financial assistance from such government, non-government and/or individual sources, including foreign sources, as decided by the Board.
- xv. To accept donations, grants, presents, gifts and other offerings in the shape of moveable and / or immovable properties for the attainment of the aims and objects of the trust.
- xvi. To purchase/acquire immovable assets in the name of the trust for the fulfilment of the aims and objects of the trust.
- xvii. To erect, construct, alter, maintain, sell, lease, mortgage, transfer, improve, develop, manage and control all or any part of the property or the building of the trust necessary or convenient for the purpose of the attainment of the aims and objects of the trust.
- xviii. To publish book, charts, illustrations, journals, magazines, periodicals, news letters/papers and other publications in different languages and on different subjects related to the objectives of the trust.
- xix. To undertake such other activities which are necessary and which may be incidental or conducive to the attainment of any of the objects of the trust.
- xx. The activities and branches/offices may spread anywhere in India and or abroad.
- xxi. All the acts/activities/programs shall be non profitable and shall be done on 'no-profit-no-loss' basis.
- xxii. The Trust will invest its money and funds according to section-11 (15) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- xxiii. All the incomes, earnings, moveable/or immoveable properties of the trust shall be utilized towards the promotion of its aims and objects only as set forth in the memorandum of the Trust and no profit there of shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits to any person claiming present, past or future Trustee No Trustee of the Trust shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immovable properties of the Trust or make any profits.

MEMBERSHIP OF THE TRUST

The trust shall have the following categories of Members. Any person, who is an adult and who has faith in the objects of the trust, can seek membership of the trust by making an application to the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees alone shall be competent to approve or disapprove, accept or reject any membership application of any individual without assigning any reason. In other words, with regard to admission of any individual as a Member, the majority decision of the Board of Trustees shall be final.

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i. **FOUNDER MEMBERS**

The first trustees, appointed by the SETTLOR on the Board of Trustees and who contribute Minimum Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand) each towards the corpus of the trust, shall be the founder Members of the trust after the trust is duly registered by the Registrar of documents as a public charitable trust.

ii. **GENERAL MEMBERS**

Any eligible person, whose name has been so approved by the Board of Trustees on an application made by him/her, would become a General Member of the Trust on making a contribution of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand).

4 **THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

- i. The SETTLOR has appointed the persons named in this Trust Deed as the Trustees to constitute the first Board of Trustees to function. The Trustees so appointed shall be named as Founder Trustees and shall continue to hold office of trustee during their life time. A founder trustee is empowered to appoint or nominate one person to become founder trustee in his place, who shall assume office in his place, after his demise. The person so appointed / nominated shall have all the power and responsibility of the founder trustee.
- ii. The number of Trustees on Board shall not be less than two and not more than Five.
- iii. The remaining trustees on the Board of Trustees, other than the Founder Trustee, shall be elected out of the General Members through voting. The General members and Founder. Members shall have the right to vote in such elections.
- iv. The trustees other than founder trustees shall hold office for a period of two years.
- v. The outgoing trustees shall also be eligible to be re-appointed to the Board of Trustees.
- vi. Any trustee shall cease to be a trustee and shall not be eligible to continue on the Board of Trustees in the event of any criminal proceedings initiated against such person. He shall be deemed to have vacated the office of trustee from the day such proceedings are initiated against him in any court of law.

5 **TERMINATION OF THE MEMBER/TRUSTEE**

The Board of Trustee shall have the powers to terminate a Trustee/Member from the trust, on the following grounds:

- i. On death
- ii. On written resignation
- iii. If found to be involved in any anti social activities

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- iv. If adjudged by any court of law to be a criminal offender
- v. If found guilty of violating the aims and objects of the trust
- vi. If he/she has not attended three consecutive meetings, without reason
- vii. If he / she disregards Rules and Regulations and disobeys decisions of the Board of Trustees.

6 POWERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Board shall have the following powers subject to the laws in force from time to time:

- i. To accept donations, contributions, grants or subscriptions in cash or kind to attain the objects of the trust.
- ii. To apply the income or corpus of the Trust towards fulfillment of the objects of the trust.
- iii. To invest and keep invested the funds in such form or forms as the Board may from time to time decide.
- iv. To buy, sell, dispose off, alienate or otherwise deal with any movable and immovable property representing the funds.
- v. To mortgage, pledge or borrow money on any of the properties of the Trust on such terms and conditions and at such rate of interest as the Board in their absolute discretion may think fit.
- vi. To take on rent or lease or license basis any immovable property on such rent and on such terms and conditions as the Board in their absolute discretion may think fit.
- vii. To open account with any bank, to operate such account and to give instructions to the bank from time to time as the Board may think necessary. However the Bank account of the trust shall only be jointly operated by any two trustees as may be decided by the Board.
- viii. To accumulate the income of the trust and apply the same towards the objects of the trust.
- ix. To make, vary, alter or modify the objects and the schemes, rules and regulations of the trust for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust or otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the trust.
- x. To amalgamate the trust with any other Trust, society or any other body having similar objects or to amalgamate any other Trust or any other body with similar objects with this Trust on such terms and conditions as the Board may in their absolute discretion think fit.

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- xi. To appoint advisory committee and other such committees and sub – committees comprising of the trustees and/or other persons, as the Board thinks necessary for the furtherance of the objects of the trust.
- xii. The Board shall be at liberty to appoint one or more of them as the Managing Trustee or Joint Managing Trustees for such time and with such powers and on such terms as may be decided by the Board.
- xiii. The Board may from time to time associate with the activities of Trust any person or persons of public eminence and may appoint or make provision for appointment of any person as Chairman of any Project undertaken by the Trust or Chairperson of any Committee constituted by the Trust for the purposes of administration of such Project/s or Scheme/s.
- xiv. The Board may employ or engage on contract or appoint as a consultant or a retainer etc any person or persons to render services on such remuneration and terms to be determined by the Board of Trustees and persons so appointed shall be accountable to the Board of Trustees.

7 EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- i. The Board of Trustees may appoint a committee to manage the day-to-day affairs of the trust on such terms and for such tenure as may be decided by the Board of Trustees. Such committee shall be called the Executive Committee.
- ii. The vacancies caused in the Executive Committee by death, resignation, retirement or otherwise shall be filled in by the Board of Trustees.
- iii. The members of the Executive Committee shall work on collective responsibility basis and be answerable to the Board of Trustees. The Executive Committee shall act under the supervision, direction and control of the Board of Trustees.
- iv. The Board of Trustees may remove any member of the Executive Committee or could dissolve such committee at any time without being bound to assign any reason for such removal of the member or dissolution of the committee.
- v. The members of the executive committee need not necessarily be the trustee of the trust.

8 ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Board may appoint an Advisory Committee to advise the Board on the activities of the Trust and to suggest how to better serve its aims and objects. The members of the Advisory Committee shall serve the Trust in honorary capacity but they may be reimbursed such expenses as may be incurred by them for attending the meetings of the Advisory Committee. The members of the Advisory Committee need not necessarily be trustee of the trust. The meetings of the Advisory Committee shall be convened by the Board of Trustees or such other person as authorized by the Board. The Members of the Advisory

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Committee will be appointed by the Board of Trustees and shall hold office for two years but they shall be eligible for reappointment.

9 **ACCOUNTS & AUDIT**

The Trust shall keep proper and regular books of accounts and shall prepare the annual statement of income and expenditure. The trust fund as may not be immediately required for any of the purposes of the Trust shall be invested in any of the investment authorised by law for the time being. The annual accounts of the trust shall be subject to audit by Chartered Accountant to be appointed by Board of Trustees.

10 **DISSOLUTION OF TRUST – LEGAL PROCEEDINGS – APPLICATION OF TRUST PROPERTIES**

- i. In the event of dissolution of Trust, the funds of the Trust represented by movable and immovable assets, shall be passed on or transferred to any other trust or trusts having similar objects as that of this trust. No part of either the corpus or accumulated funds of the trust shall get vested in the hands of the trustees of the dissolved trust.
- ii. All suits and proceedings pertaining to Trust, the Trust property or properties can be instituted, commenced and/or prosecuted in the name of the trust by any person so authorised by the Board and such person shall be entitled to take all steps and/or defend all suits and proceedings that may be instituted against the trust.
- iii. It is hereby expressly declared that no part of the Trust property or its income shall be applied for any purpose which is not a public charitable purpose. To utilize the trust property or the income thereof for any non-charitable or private purpose, such powers and provision herein contained shall be treated as omitted, replaced and cancelled by this clause.

11 **RESIDUARY CLAUSES**

- i. The Trustees shall not be entitled to receive any remuneration but shall be reimbursed all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the trust or other duties relating thereto.
- ii. Each Trustee shall have only one vote. In case of any difference of opinion amongst the Trustees the decision of the majority of them will prevail. In case of equality of votes, chairman of the Meeting shall have a casting vote.
- iii. Any Trustee other than founder Trustee may be removed from office at any time by a written direction of the 2/3rd majority of the Board of Trustee. It shall not be necessary to disclose or assign any reason for such removal.
- iv. No Trustee shall be liable for any loss to the Trust arising by reason of any improper investment made in good faith or for the negligence or fraud of any agent employed by him or by any other Trustee hereof.

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- v. Each Trustee shall be liable for his own receipts, defaults or negligence only and not for the receipts/defaults or negligence of any of his co-trustees.
- vi. If any Trustee may at any time be desirous of withdrawing or being discharged from his responsibility as a trustee hereof, he may do so by writing to the Board of Trustees for the time being

12 ALTERATION AND INTEPRETTION OF RULES AND REGULATION

- i. The Board of Trustees shall be empowered to frame rules and regulation for conducting affairs of the trust.
- ii. Amendments to the Rules and Regulation of the Trust may be made either jointly by all the founder trustees or by Board of Trustees by 3/4th Majority and approved by the founder Trustees.
